Service Catalog

- Engaging consultant to "jump start" planning
- Balancing service portfolio & tech info needed for Configuration Management Database (CMDB)

ServiceNow Implementation Roadmap

- Deployed apps with Facilities, CALS, DELTA, and Campus Enterprises
 - Expanding support and personnel to address demand

Cyberinfrastructure Masterplan

- Planning work progressing on new data center
- Beacon focus group discussing guidelines for efficient deployment

First-Round Initiatives

Redesign Governance

- Draft plan completed in August
- Focus on preserving inclusive nature while simplifying and clarifying structure

Optimizing Space/Technology Alignment

 Draft plan being finalized for first design & construction standards for focusing on common areas

Data-based Decision Making

- Realtime enrollment stats for all students with unified dashboard
 - Partnering with SAS to optimize enrollment forecasting

- Expanding Imaging, ServiceNow, Mendix
- Will begin planning for work on guest and affiliate accounts
- Replacement for Security Access Request (SAR) system
- Moving PeopleSoft to Exadata platform
- NIST research compliance requirements
 - Secure University Research Environment (SURE)
 - Near-term process leverages Amazon Web Services
 - Developing longer-term processes
- Continued focus on Cyber Security
 - Endpoint security
 - Spirion/Identity Finder
 - Partnering with Security Liaisons
- EHRA move for IT positions
